RECIPE: Butterfly Pretzels

Ingredients:

- Celery stalks
- Peanut butter
- Raisins
- Pretzels

Instructions:

1. Ask an adult to cut the celery into 2-inch lengths.
2. Spread peanut butter on top of each celery stick.
3. Add a line of raisins on top of the peanut butter.
4. On each piece of celery, push the bottom end of a pretzel into the peanut butter along one side of the raisins to create a butterfly wing. Repeat with another pretzel on the opposite side of the raisins.

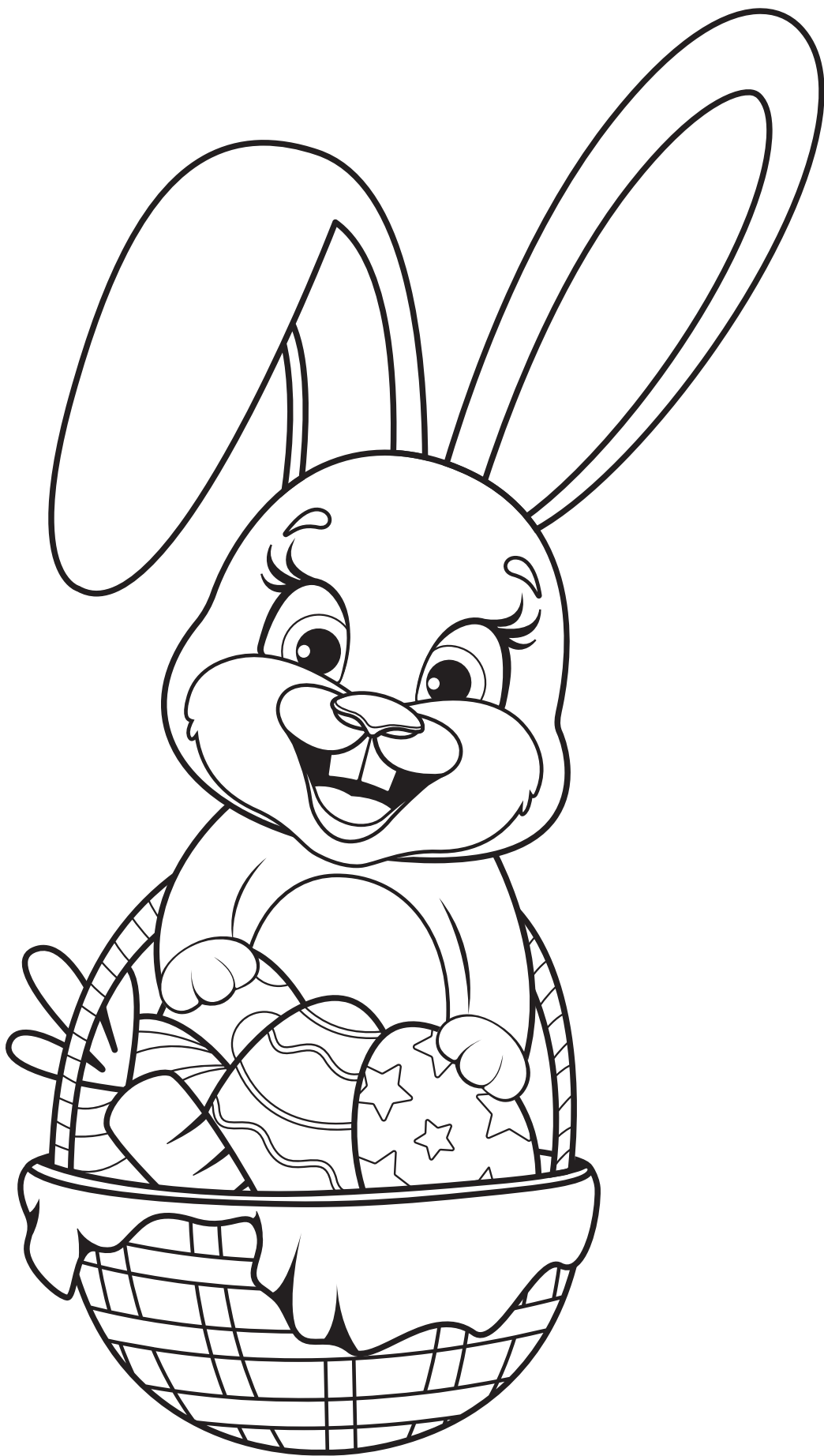
